James TEAM MANAGER of the escalated complaints department at HSBC organised 3 teams across 3 separate days to help with our big Christmas Project.


They were some of the unfortunate teams who lifted and carried large bulk orders of food and supplies and helped to organise and wrap our hamper boxes.

Carbon Monoxide – The Silent Killer

You can't see it, taste it, or smell it, but Carbon Monoxide (CO) can kill.

What is CO?

Carbon Monoxide is a poisonous gas that is produced when gas, oil, solid fuels and liquid petroleum gas (LPG) do not burn fully. It can occur when an appliance has been incorrectly fitted, badly repaired or poorly maintained.

Spotting the signs



Lazy yellow or orange flames (rather than crisp and blue) on a gas appliance



Dark staining around/on appliances



Pilot lights frequently blowing out



Increased condensation on windows

What should I do if I suspect CO poisoning?

- Call the National Gas Emergency Service on 0800 111 999
- Turn off appliances, open doors & windows and leave the property
- See your doctor immediately or go to the hospital

Recognising the symptoms

- Headaches
- Dizziness
- Nausea
- Breathlessness
- Collapse
- Loss of consciousness

Stay safe...

At home

- Install an audible CO alarm.
- Get your appliances serviced by a qualified engineer once a year.

On the water

 In large boats, such as houseboats, it is important to make sure that any gasolinepowered engines on boats are checked regularly

Camping and barbecues

- Even when the flames have gone out smouldering coals can still kill. Never bring a barbecue or camping stove inside an enclosed area, such as a tent
- If you are heading on a boat trip or camping holiday, pack a CO alarm





The cost-of-living crisis has compounded fuel and food poverty but also around housing costs and other essential items. Our ambition is to alleviate as much of this where possible, by providing support to address needs specific to our communities.

- Raising awareness of energy efficiency measures, to help reduce fuel poverty.
- Help with understanding and managing your energy bills.

- Advising about the Priority Service Register and signing up households to this.
- Provide support around money management, income maximisation, benefit and access to services.
- Provide advice on cooking nutritious meals more efficiently and less costly.
- Reduce isolation by encouraging people to attend social groups.
- Providing people with energy saving appliances and items to help people stay warm and improve their energy efficiency.

All this is provided in a warm safe environment designed to:

- Improve health, mental health and wellbeing
- Increase household income
- Help communities better manage their energy consumption
